Recent resurgences of the COVID-19 pandemic's effects have caused the Secretariat to relook the dates for 2021. To that end, the AAPT Chairman (Vietnam) and Secretariat met via VTC to address this extraordinary situation and its implications for the organization of the 2020, 2021, and 2022 annual conferences.

After much consideration, it was decided to postpone the AGM into the end of April 2021 (**from 26 April to 01 May 2021 tentatively**), pending the stabilization of the COVID-19 pandemic; and continue Vietnam as the Chair of AAPT for the rescheduled AGM.
