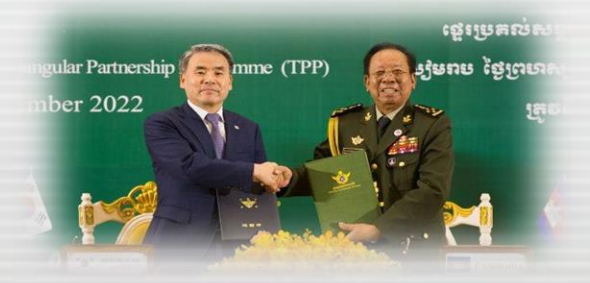

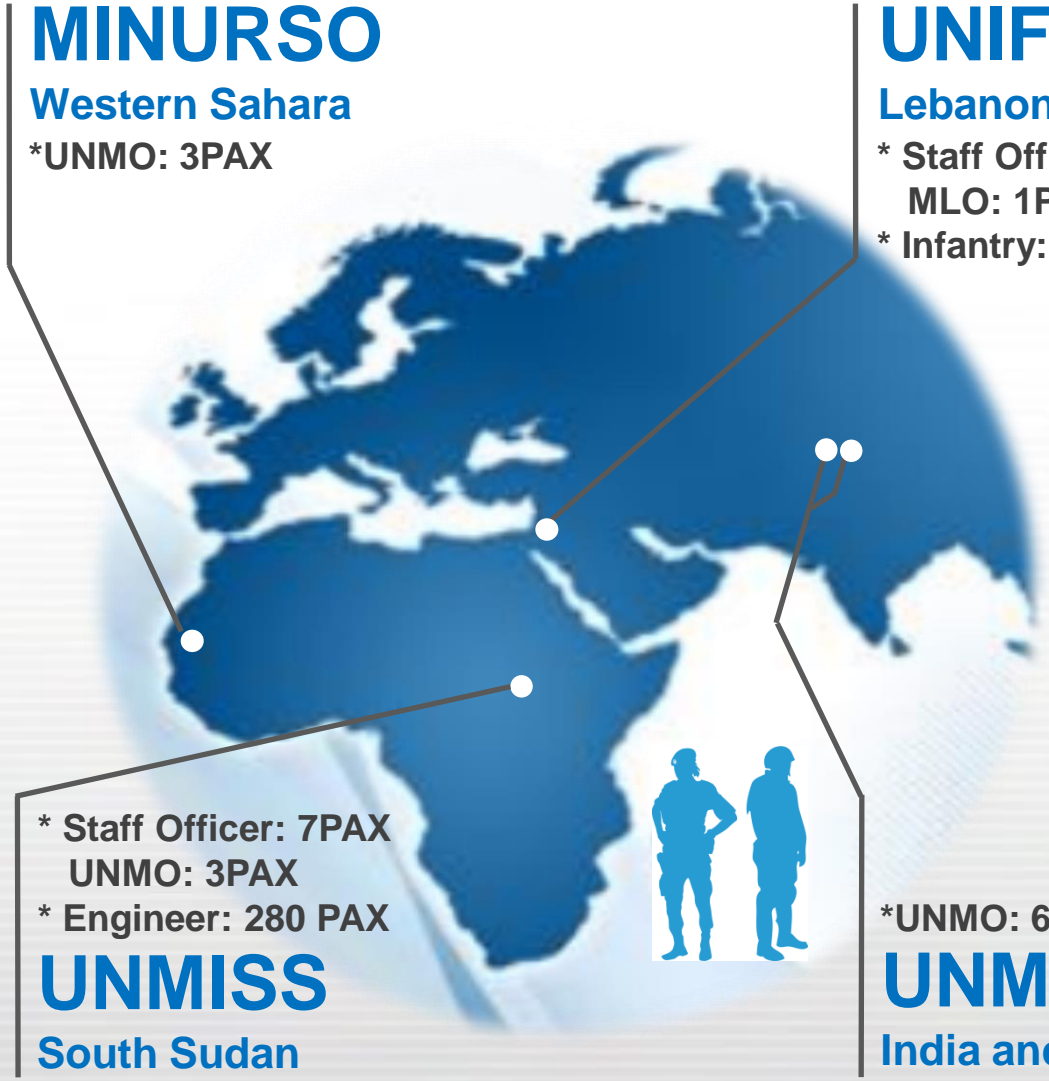

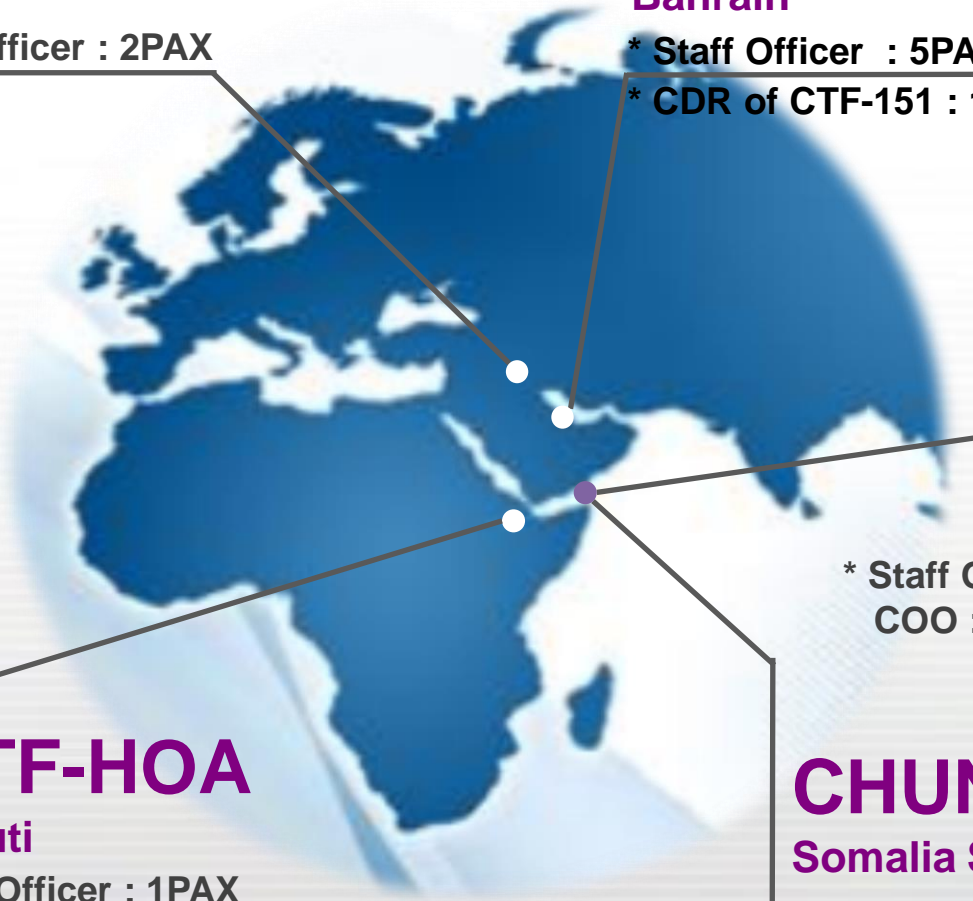

- **(ROK) Training Pilots & Mechanics of Kenya & El Salvador** in Army Aviation School (24PAX, Q2)

- Eight (8) **El Salvador** Pilots and Mechanics are being trained in ROK (Apr.)

- Twelve(12) **Kenya** Pilots and Mechanics will be trained in ROK (May.)





- To enhance the capacity of **engineering for peacekeepers** through the provision of **training & HEE\*** to **TCC**.

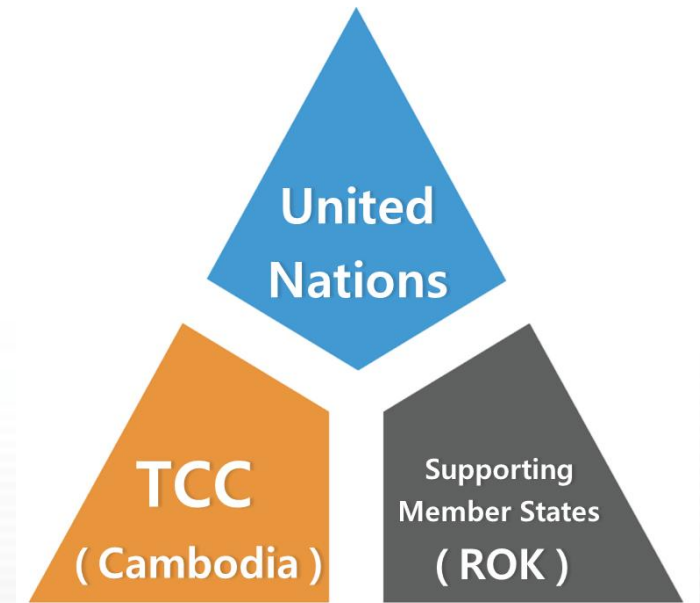
