

Contribute 16 Helicopters to MINUSMA

- Contribute 16 Helicopters (500MD) through partnership with UN & US (El Salvador & Kenya) to deploy to UN PKO in Africa (MINUSMA, etc.).
 - 1st Transfer of six(6) Heli by Apr 2nd Transfer of ten(10) Heli by 2024
 - * In cooperation with the US Department of State
- (ROK) Training Pilots & Mechanics of Kenya & El Salvador in Army Aviation School (24PAX, Q2)
 - Eight (8) El Salvador Pilots and Mechanics are being trained in ROK (Apr.)
 - Twelve(12) Kenya Pilots and Mechanics will be trained in ROK (May.)



- Signing ceremony of TPP between ROK and Cambodia through UN in 2022.
- HEE Transfer (1st : Feb, 2nd : Sep) & Training in NPMEC Cambodia from 2023.
 - * From 2024, ICW redesign of UN TPP, Expand to Multi-national training, (case study) Demining, Medical & Quarantine training
 * NPMEC: National Center for Peacekeeping Forces









• WMPOC* hold in Korea from 2023 ~ 2027

- * WMPOC: Women's Military Peace Operations Course
- (Host) UN Women Collaborate with UN ITS and ROK PKO Center
- (Purpose) Empowering military women in the United Nations Mission.
