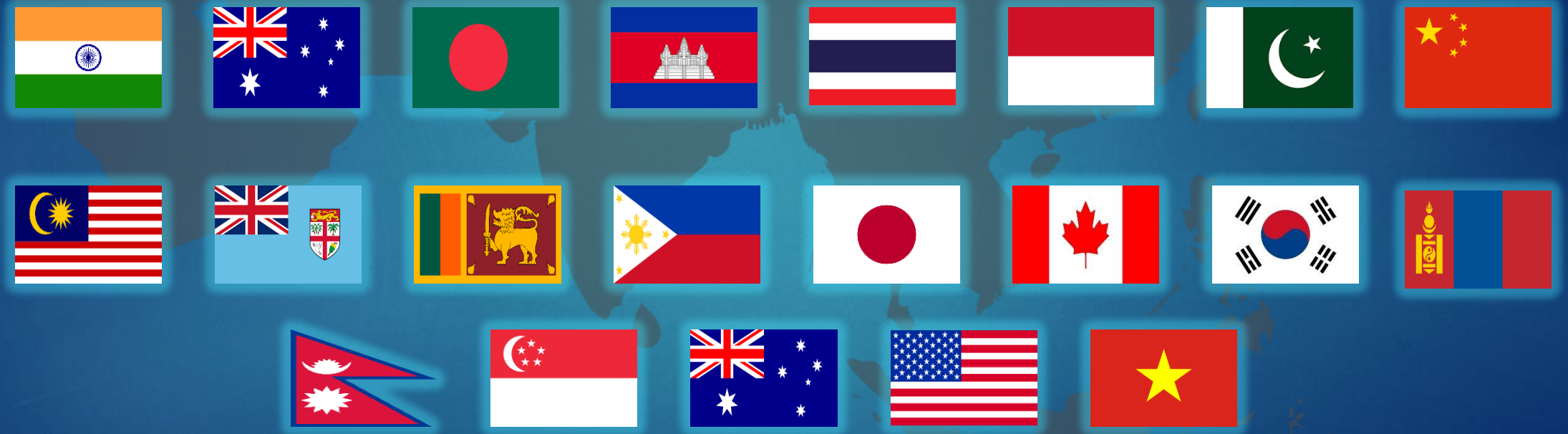

NUMBER OF FEMALE PERSONNEL IN UN PEACEKEEPING MISSIONS¹

PAST 1957-1989 (32 years) a total of only twenty uniformed women served as UN peacekeepers

PRESENT Women have become increasingly part of the peacekeeping family



Women are deployed in all areas: police, military, civilian. **WE NEED MORE WOMEN.**

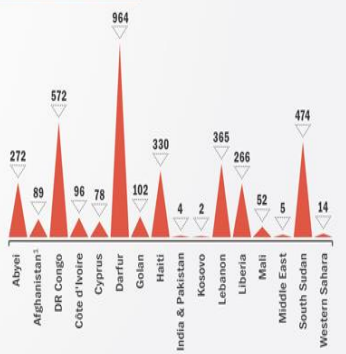

PRO WOMEN'S LEGISLATION

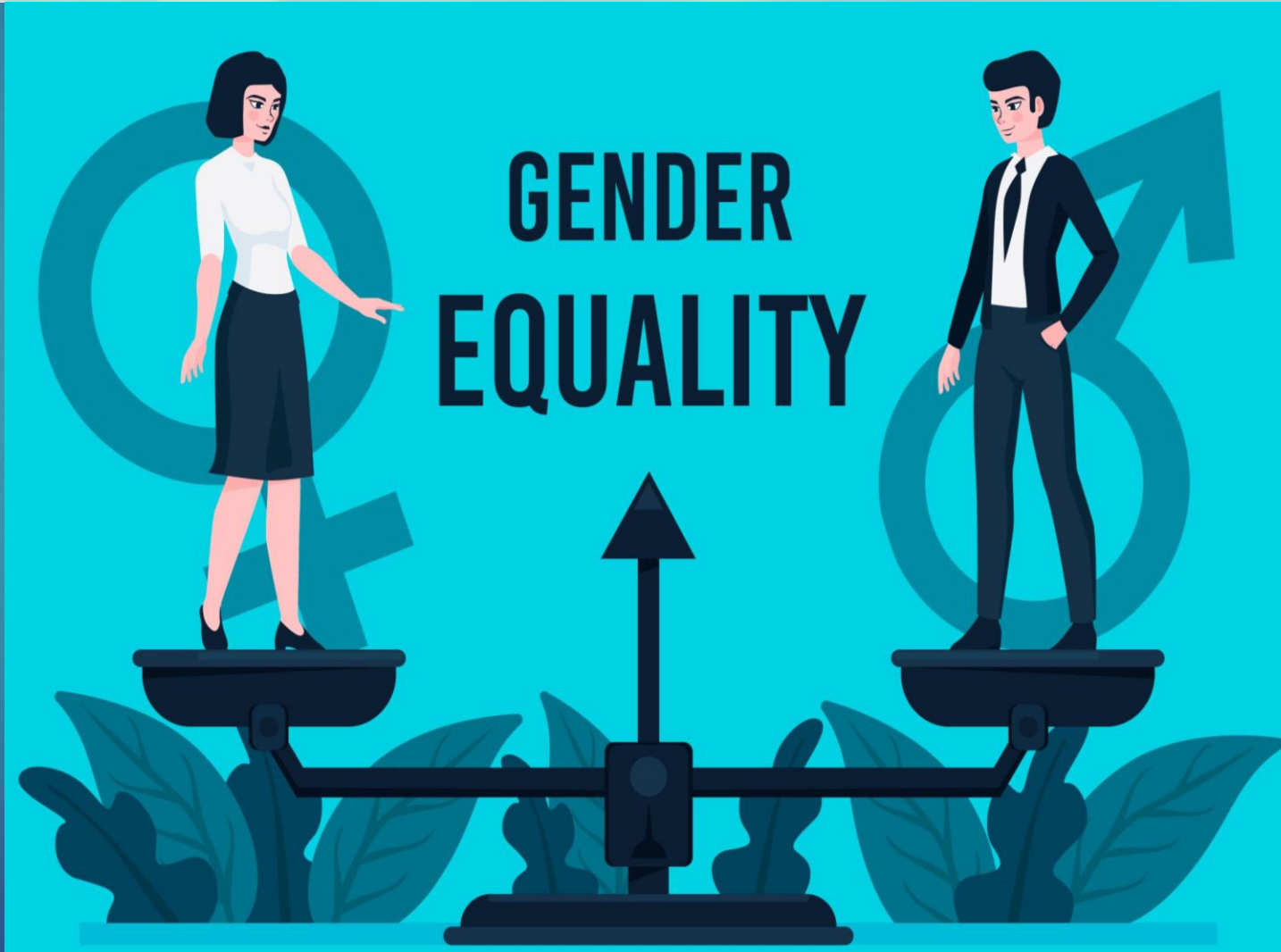


The Magna Carta of Women is comprehensive women's human rights law that seeks to eliminate discrimination against women by recognizing, protecting, fulfilling and promoting the rights of Filipino women, especially those in marginalized sectors.



R.A 7192, directs all government agencies to institute measure that would eliminate gender bias in government policies, programs and project, to ensure that women are given the means to participate fully in development and nation building.

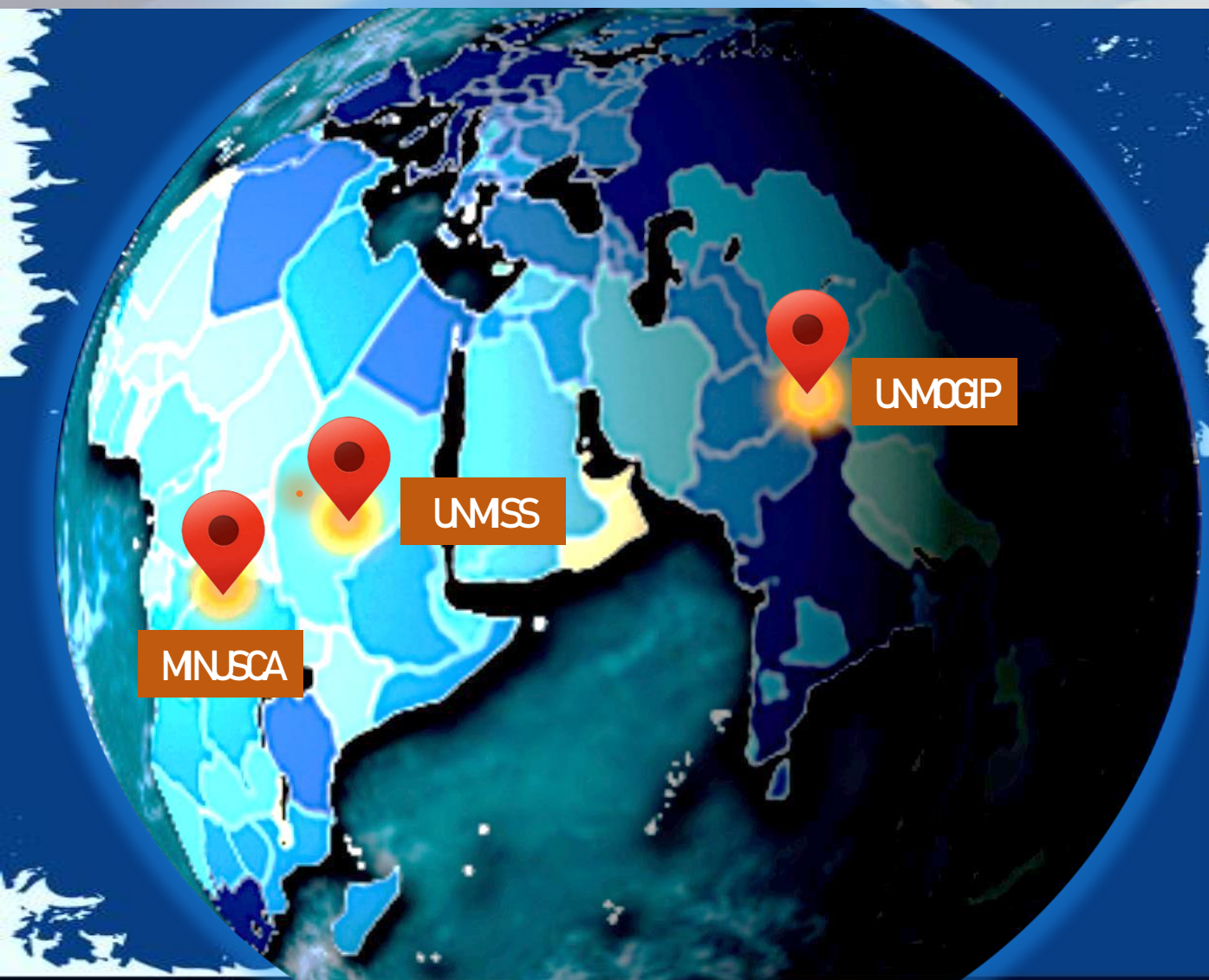

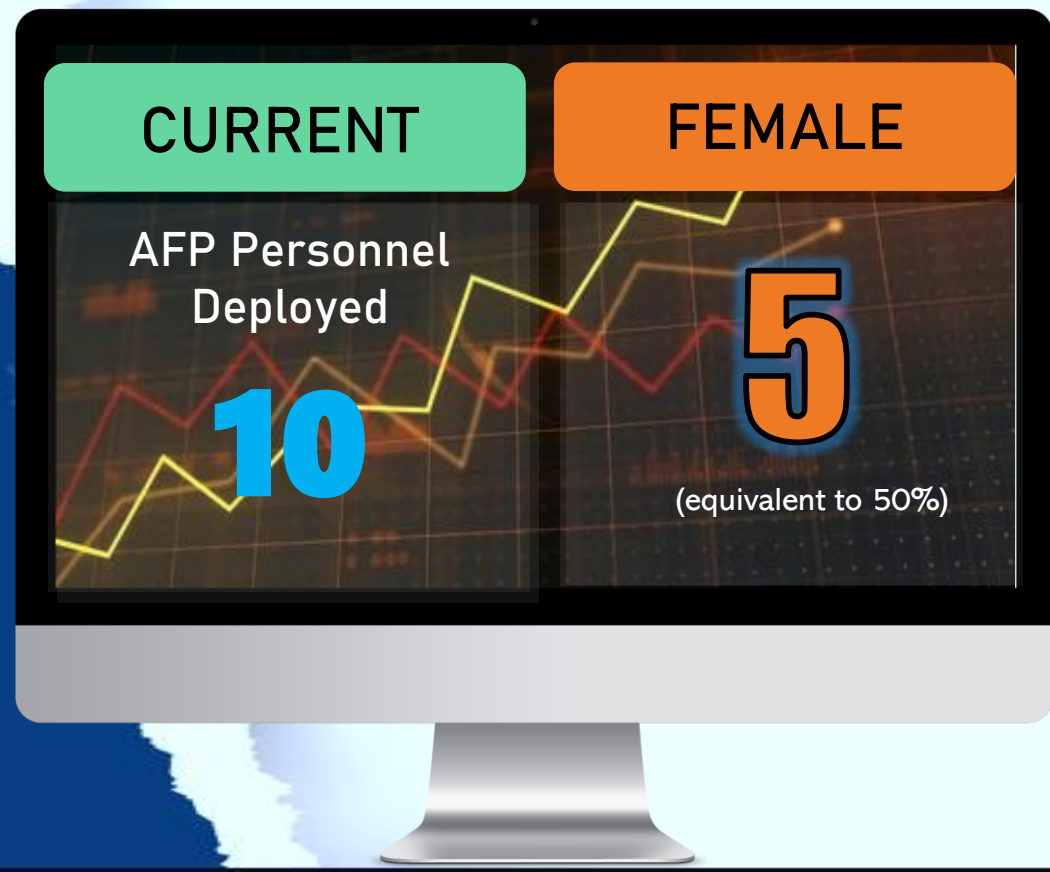




MARAW CONFLICT SUCCESS STORY
